**T**he work of the Pensions Board extends far beyond the provision of pensions. A range of Retirement Housing options such as *homes for rent, supported housing, or nursing care* are equally important parts of the support offered by the Board to its pensioners, including clergy widows and widowers and licensed lay workers.

In 2008 the Board is celebrating the 60th Anniversary of the provision of Retirement Housing and, in particular, its supported housing complexes.

These Christian communities have been designed specifically for the needs of elderly people with individual flats and facilities offering independence, companionship and communal worship.

The Board's charitable funds give financial support to clergy pensioners in need. The funds can help those on a low income or assist with fees and are completely separate from the pension scheme. These funds must rely solely for their resources on the generosity of PCCs and individual Church members.
