

***Form of Words for use in a residuary bequest
to the Church of England Pensions Board,
for its General Charitable Purposes***

I give all the rest and residue of my real and personal property whatsoever and wheresoever situate (including any property over which I may have a general power of appointment or disposition by will) to my (executors/trustees) for the payment of my debts funeral and testamentary expenses legacies all duties and taxes on any legacy gift devise or annuity given free of duty or tax and subject thereto to the General Purposes Fund of the Church of England Pensions Board of 29 Great Smith Street, Westminster, London SW1P 3PS (registered charity no. 236627) as constituted under the Church of England Pensions Measures 1961 to 2003 or any statutory amendment or re-enactment of the same and I declare that a receipt signed by the Secretary or other proper officer of the said Board shall be a full and sufficient receipt and discharge for the same.

Note 1:

This is a suggested form of wording and may need to be adapted by the testator's legal adviser to suit individual circumstances. Prospective testators should seek advice from their own solicitors in drawing up their will.

Note 2:

The charitable funds of the Board are principally used for providing and maintaining homes for retired clergy of the Church of England and their spouses and the widows or widowers of clergy who have died in retirement or while still in service. They are also used for making similar provision for retired licensed lay workers and their widows or widowers.
